Always Caring, Last to be Cared For

They give all to their kids and families, often sacrificing their own health. In partnership with Overlake Hospital, volunteer Patricia coordinated Women's Health Day. Through a team of 23 volunteer medical professionals, with assistance from Cornerstone and other churches, 50 underserved women received PAP tests, clinical breast exams, mammograms and screening with follow up from Overlake. "I've never felt better serving," said one volunteer as moist eyes declared the grateful joy of moms.



PEER Relationships

Learning relational skills prepares Care Givers to come alongside parents and families in our community in crisis. The art of listening, affirming, inspiring hope, in what we call a PEER relationship that offers a genuine "hand up" during those critical seasons in an individual's life or the life of a family. Presence, Empathy, Encouragement and Resources may help lift someone from despair to repair and



restoration. Over 24 people from four partner churches led by Lighthouse, Issaquah Christian, Westminster Chapel and First Presbyterian Bellevue completed JRC's 12 hour Community Caregiver training. "I'm a fixer," said
